Position Overview

A Committee Member of Bicycle Wagga Wagga Inc.(BWW) plays a vital role in promoting safe, inclusive, and sustainable cycling opportunities within the local community. This volunteer position involves participating in decision-making, planning events, and supporting BWW's strategic objectives to foster a thriving cycling culture.

Key Responsibilities

- Attend and actively participate in regular committee meetings, typically held monthly or as required.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of BWW strategies, policies, and initiatives.
- Assist in organising and running community cycling events, rides, and workshops.
- Engage with members, volunteers, and the wider community to promote cycling and encourage participation.
- Support fundraising activities, grant applications, and sponsorship opportunities.
- Help manage BWW's communications, including newsletters, social media, and community outreach.
- Ensure compliance with relevant legislation, safety standards, and best practices in cycling activities.



- Participate in sub-committees or working groups as needed (e.g. events, advocacy, membership).
- Represent BWW at local events, meetings, or forums, championing cycling issues and initiatives.
- Assist in maintaining accurate records and reporting on committee activities.

Desirable Skills and Attributes

- Passion for cycling and active transport.
- Strong communication and teamwork skills.
- Organisational and planning abilities.
- Experience in community engagement or volunteer organisations (advantageous but not essential).
- Willingness to take initiative and contribute ideas.
- Basic computer skills (email, word processing, social media).
- Understanding of the local area and its cycling needs.

Term and Accountability

A Committee Member:-

- is elected by the membership at the Annual General Meeting and serves a term as defined by BWW's constitution;
- shall act in accordance with the BWW constitution, policies & guidelines and is accountable to the committee and the broader membership; and
- is expected to act with integrity and in the best interests of BWW at all times.

Time Commitment

Committee Members are generally expected to attend monthly meetings (usually monthly), participate in the AGM, assist with events throughout the year, and contribute to ongoing tasks as agreed within the committee. The overall time commitment is flexible and can vary depending on Club needs and personal availability.
